Remarkable Events of Shishu Bikash Kendra

1. **SBK report for the month of January 5, 2020 Book Festival was held at the SBK.** Government Primary School Text Books were distributed among the students.
2. President of Zonta Club Dhaka III Ms Khadija Afzal has visited ZSBK with Ms Nazma Altaf on January 25, 2020. Discussion on celebrating 20 years SBK project of Zonta Club Dhaka III. School development was held there,
3. President of Zonta Club Dhaka III Ms Khadija Afzal provided food among the teachers and students on the death anniversary of her mother Begum Sayeda Ali Afzal on 25 January 2020.
4. Zonta Club of Dhaka III celebrated 20 years with a cultural show presented by the students of ZSBK on 31 January. Venue was WVA Auditorium, Dhanmondi, Dhaka.
5. Sweaters distributed to the 160 students staffs of SBK a free school run by Zonta Club Dhaka III at Rayer Bazar on January 25,2020
6. **International Mother Language Day** was celebrated at ZSBK School on February 22, 2020. Art competition was also arranged on this day by ZSBK.
7. Total 56 prizes were awarded for writing and painting, sewing and merit among the students of ZSBK.

SBK could not organize International Women's Day, Independence Day, International literacy day, Victory Day, Art Competition due to shutdown of COVID 19 Pandemic from March 18 2020 till 7 December, 2020.

Food Aid and Distribution during COVID 19 Pandemic



- SBK has distributed Tk 2000 / student's family for purchase of food grains for 160 families on April 23, 2020.

SBK has distributed Tk 500 / students and Tk 500 / parents to purchase food grains on May 15, 2020.



- SBK also distributed two times food packs among 160 students consists of 5 Kg rice, 1 Kg pulse, 1 Kg sugar 1 kg salt 1 kg potato 1 litre oil, 1 pack shemai in each pack with a value of Tk 700 / packs on June 7, 2020
- SBK also distributed Tk 500/ student for 160 students as gift to celebrate Eidul Azha on July 21, 2020
- SBK also distributed food packs among 160 students per pack Tk 700 on August 18, 2020.
- Zonta also provided Tk 400,000 as additional cash grant for purchase of food items.
- Packets of food were given twice. In August, 500.00 BDT was given to each student.
- Masks were distributed among the students and parents.

Repair and Renovation of of Door and Windows of SBK

All the doors and windows of the school building have been painted. New doors have been installed in one of the two bathrooms. The other bathroom had new tiles on the floor. Commode, mirrors and soap cases have also been installed in this bathroom. The kitchen doors and windows have been painted. The kitchen has also been repaired in a new way during mid June 2020.

SBK started special coaching from June 2020

From June SBK had started special coaching giving worksheets/assignments among the students of class V, VI and VII from 10 am to 1 pm. So far 20 to 30 students were coming every Tuesday of every week. All the teachers were also present during this day. Students were submitting these assignments later by next week. Teachers were checking their assignments in every week.

18.08.2020: Death anniversary of Neelu Apa's mother,

Food was distributed among the SBK students on the occasion of the **death anniversary of Neelu Apa's mother**, aunt and grandmother on 18/8/2020. Five kgs of rice, one kg of salt, sugar, soap, Missouri pulses, potatoes, semai, one litre oil were distributed to the parents of the students. Help is being provided every month. The process of education is being continued from 4th to 7th class.

Requisition letter for the book of 2021

The **requisition letter for the text books 2021** has been submitted to Dhanmondi Education Office. Awareness is being given how to stay away from the transmission of corona virus; emphasis is being laid on cleanliness.

09.10.2020:

Program named "**Psychological effects of Corona virus**" held on 9/10/2020. At first SBK gave idea about corona virus to the students. Then several students wrote about it and even presented it verbally. 2 students were awarded 5th class student names Tanjil and Mukta.

15.11.2020:
